3. A rise in _____ - **Matthew 24:7b** - *...and there will be famines .- **Revelation 6:5-8***

4. A rise in _____ - **Matthew 24:7c - 8** - *...earthquakes in various places. ⁸ All these are but the beginning of the birth pains.*

5. A rise in _____ - **Matthew 24:9-10** - *Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and put you to death, and you will be hated by all nations for my name's sake.*

6. A rise in _____ - **Matthew 24:11** - *And many false prophets will arise and lead many astray.*

7. A rise in _____ - **Matthew 24:12 & 13** - *And because lawlessness will be increased, the love of many will grow cold. ¹³ But the one who endures to the end will be saved.*

8. A rise in _____ - **Matthew 24:14** - *And this gospel of the kingdom will be proclaimed throughout the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come. – **Revelation 7:3-4***


1. We are not to live _____ - **Matthew 24:36** - *But concerning that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, nor the Son, but the Father only.*

2. We are not to live _____ - **Matthew 24:37-39** - *For as were the days of Noah, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. ³⁸ For as in those days before the flood they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day when Noah entered the ark, ³⁹ and they were unaware until the flood came and swept them all away, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.*

3. We are to live _____ - **Matthew 24:42-43** - *Therefore, stay awake, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. ⁴³ But know this, that if the master of the house had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and would not have let his house be broken into.*

4. We are to live _____ - **Matthew 24:44** - *Therefore you also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.*

5. We are to live _____ - **Matthew 24:45-46** - *Who then is the faithful and wise servant, whom his master has set over his household, to give them their food at the proper time? ⁴⁶ Blessed is that servant whom his master will find so doing when he comes.*
